The 5th National Magnesium Symposium “Magnesium In Therapy: Actual Concepts”

București, Romania, 3-4 November, 2005

Romanian Society for Magnesium Research (SRMR), joined to the International Society for the Development of Magnesium Research, organized on 3 and 4 November, 2005, the 5th National Magnesium Symposium “Magnesium in therapy: actual concept”. Although this society has a relatively narrow research field, it comprises ardent researchers who have praiseworthy results. As acknowledgement of Romanian Magnesium researches, in 2004, the 8th European Magnesium Congress took place in Cluj-Napoca, for the first time in Eastern Europe.

The National Magnesium Symposium from this year emphasized, by plenary lectures and

oral presentations, the role of Magnesium in cardiovascular diseases, infectious diseases, in reproduction, digestive pathology, etc.

The symposium included also an National Course on Magnesium field presented by remarkable personality of the Romanian medical school: prof. Zeana C., prof. Porr P., prof. Guțiu IA, prof. Nechifor M.,

The Institute of Public Health Iași was represented by 3 presentations, one regarding the relationship of Magnesium during pregnancy with the health of the newborn and suckling and two papers about the variation of Magnesium level in workers.
